Your course will remain on the FAA's active list of accepted IA renewal courses for 24 calendar-months unless suspended or removed for cause.

Before the end of the 24 calendar-month period, you must provide the IA Refresher Course Coordinator (IA RCC) with a request for course renewal acceptance in accordance with current guidelines. If you do not provide this request at least **60** working days before the end of the 24-month period, we will remove your course from the list of acceptable courses.

As a provider of an FAA-accepted IA training course, you must comply with current guidance to remain valid.

Your course is subject to FAA review. If the reviewing FAA Aviation Safety Inspector determines that your course does not meet the guidelines, you will receive notification.

Your FAA-accepted course number, **C-IND-IM-120103-K-006-001**, will expire **January 31, 2013**.
